

Economic scenario of Thailand

Thailand ranked 29th among 85 world's best countries on the 2023 edition of the U.S. News & World Report, with high rankings in open for business, showcasing its potential as a leading global destination for investment opportunities. With a strong economic growth rate, increasing global influence, and commitment to establish a "Value-based Innovation Driven Economy" by embracing cutting-edge technologies for modernizing industries and enhancing productivity. Thailand's economy has continued to move forward with remarkable progress in social and economic development, moving from a low-income to an upper middle-income country in less than a generation.

Real GDP Growth rate of Thailand (2018 to 2023)



India and Thailand's Bilateral Trade

Thailand is among the top 20 export destination for the Indian engineering industry and 2nd largest in the ASEAN region. It has been among India's top 25 global partners and was the 21st largest trading partner in 2022-23. Between 2018-19 and 2022-23, India's exports to Thailand increased from USD 4.44 billion to USD 5.71 billion. However, there is still significant potential for expansion.

The product elfiorpof Thailand's Agritechnica Asia 2024 consists of products related to agriculture machinery such as Tractors, front loaders, machinery and equipment for soil working, sowing, etc. under the engineering industry. In 2022-23, India's exports of Industrial Machinery for dairy, Agriculture stood at USD 8.51 billion which is 6.5% growth over the same period last year. India holds the place among Thailand's top 10 suppliers for agricultural machinery with a share of 2.7% in Thailand's overall import of agricultural machinery.









Opportunity for Indian Agricultural machinery in Thailand

Thailand is known worldwide for all its agricultural output for which agricultural machinery is an important input. Growing demand for these machines over the years have placed them among the major product groups in the global import basket of Thailand. In coming years, the country will become an even more substantial market for the Indian supplier, reflecting an ample scope in this product segment. In this background, it is an apt time for India to response to the demand of the agricultural machinery industry of Thailand and enhance its share in the Thai market through participation in the Agritechnica Asia 2024.

Re-imbursement of Airfare:

Up to Rs. 90,000 may be reimbursed to eligible participants in terms of the MAI guidelines. However, this shall be subject to receiving of specific Govt. approval for such assistance for events of 2024-25. The T&C must be abided by for eligibility towards such re-imbursement. Note: EEPC INDIA can only recommend for issuance of VISA to the extent that the concerned person is a participant at the subject exhibition and that the person in question has been certified by the participating organisation to be their representative. The Foreign Embassy/ Consulate where the applicant submits the VISA application is expected to follow their usual procedural checks before granting the VISA in question and EEPC INDIA shall not be responsible in any manner whatsoever for non-issuance of VISA by the concerned authorities. This would mean that the prospective participant will be fully liable for the total charges payable to EEPC INDIA even if they do not obtain the VISA for any reason whatsoever.

Re-imbursement Guidelines



Re-imbursement of Freight:

MSME participants may also be reimbursed 50% of the freight charges for carrying exhibits to this exhibition, subject, however, to a limit of Rs. 50,000 (Rs. Fifty Thousand only). The eligibility criteria would be similar to those applicable for airfare re-imbursement.

However, this shall be subject to receiving of specific Govt. approval for such assistance for events of 2024-25.

In the unlikely event of not receiving Government sanction, additional amount shall be required to be paid by the participants.

Selection Criteria

Since limited space is available, selection of participation will be done strictly on first-come, first-served basis.

Benefit to the Member-Exporters

EEPC India is proposing to organise this event under the MAI Scheme of Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India. The rates mentioned above are subsidized in comparison with the normal rates offered by the Fair Authorities and is in anticipation of receiving the government approval. In case the same is not received, additional payment shall be required to be made by the participants to confirm booking.

Cancellation of Participation

Please note that no request for cancellation and/ or refund including of advances, if any and/ or adjustment thereof shall be accepted for any reason whatsoever. Once the application form and/ or advance/ part payments are accepted by EEPC India the participant remains liable to pay in entirety the amounts due from them on account of the event. In case members are not able to travel due to travel restrictions/advisory by Government of India or Thailand then the amount paid will be adjusted toward the participation in the next edition.



Force Majeure

If a Force Majeure Event like war, act of God, natural calamities, governmental directives, civil commotion, epidemic, pandemic, etc. or alike events occurs inasmuch as that the fair authorities/ organizers consider that it is illegal, impossible, inadvisable or impracticable for the physical, onsite and in-person (i.e. 'live') elements of the Event to be staged, then in such situation and/ or circumstances the decision of the fair authorities shall be final and binding upon EEPC India and all its co-exhibitors/ participants. In such situation and/ or circumstances, if the fair authorities, organizers or the vendors appointed for providing diverse services related to the Event in question does not refund the monies paid by EEPC India and/ or does not otherwise absolve EEPC India from its contractual obligations then in such case the Co-exhibitors / participants remain liable to pay to EEPC India the contracted participation charge in full and shall not receive any refund from EEPC India of the amounts paid by the co-exhibitors/ participants. Further, if the fair authorities, organizers or the vendors, so appointed for the Event binds or rolls over EEPC India's participation in the future editions of the same Event in question, then automatically the participation of the co-exhibitor/ participant shall also be carried forward to such future editions of the Event and the amounts paid by them shall be given a credit for the successive edition. However, if there is any increment in the participation fees fixed by the fair authorities, organizers or in any other charges, budgets, etc. then such increased amount has to be paid by the co-exhibitor/ participant without any demur based on the space and booth booked by the co-exhibitor/participant. In any event, a co-exhibitor/participant cannot decrease the space or the booth size booked by them for the originally scheduled Event.

Note: Regarding goods taken out of India for exhibition or on consignment basis for export promotion, participants may refer to Circular No. 108/27/2019-GST dated 18.07.2019 of the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) which is the statute in the matter.
